The expert appraisal/approval by licensed experts and/or specialists is required for submission of Design Documents or any part thereof to the relevant Georgian Authority for obtaining or as a part of Construction Permit.”</p> <p>“2.3.7 CONSULTANT, together with EMPLOYER and CONTRACTOR, shall approve each completed phase of the construction of CCTPP PROJECT (as defined in the Construction Permit from Relevant Authorities) by signing of the relevant Act on Completion of Construction Phase.
